- 1. There are 42 tree species in Harrison Park West.
- 2. I think we are fine for people to give answers, such as apple tree, cherry tree, lime tree, willow, poplar, birch, etc. For completeness, I have listed all tree species in Harrison Park West detected by the app PictureThis on the second page.
- 3. There are 23 tree species from Scotland and 19 tree species from foreign countries in Harrison Park West.
- 4. There are 9 fruit tree species in Harrison Park West, among them apple, pear, cherry plum, cherry, mulberry, and peach trees.
- 5. Harrison Park was established in 1886 and that was when the first trees were planted.
- 6. The plaques indicate trees which have been planted as a donation as part of the initiative Tree Time. The charity Edinburgh & Lothians Greenspace Trust organises the Tree Time tree donations.
- 7. The small-leaved lime tree develops round-to-oval smooth fruits with pointed tips.
